

Rotary Club of Waupaca Inclement Weather Policy

Inclement weather should always be taken seriously and staying on top of rapidly changing weather conditions is always a challenge that may require the cancelation of a regular Rotary meeting. It is important that our members have a clear method to know when a meeting needs to be canceled due to concerns about safe travel.

Inclement Weather Policy: The Rotary Club of Waupaca will follow the School District of Waupaca decision to keep schools open or to close them due to inclement weather. If schools are closed or are having a remote learning day, the regular Rotary meeting will be canceled.

Procedure:

1. If inclement weather occurs, an email will be sent to all members the day before a regular meeting informing them of the possibility that the meeting could be canceled.
2. As the school district tends to make the school closing (remote learning) decision early the next morning, members will be directed to the following to determine if the schools are closed and that the Rotary meeting is canceled:
 - a. TV Channels: 2,5,7,9,11, and 26
 - b. Radio Stations: WDUX Radio 92.7FM and 800 AM
 - c. School District website and Facebook page
3. An email will be sent to all members in the morning confirming that the regular meeting is canceled or will be held.

If the school district decides to keep schools open, the Rotary meeting will be held, but members should make their own decision concerning safely traveling to the meeting.
